I refer to your request received by the Crown Response Office (CRO) on 2 July 2025, which has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA). You requested the following information regarding the Survivor Support and Recognition Fund (SSRF):

- b) *In lieu of the above information, please provide a list of the non-government organisations and community groups that are/have been granted funding (as soon as this information is available).*
- c) *A list of non-government organisations and community groups you are aware of that currently provide specialised support to survivors of abuse (whether funded or not).*

In response to points a) and b) of your request, information on the non-government organisations and community groups who have been granted funding is publicly available.

Published information about SSRF recipients does not include applications that have not been processed and completed.


In response to point c) your request is refused under section 18(e) of the OIA as the information requested does not exist and would need to be created in order to respond because information is not collected in this way.
